



# Ready for Christmas 4 Panel Card

## Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets** – Ready for Christmas Bundle; At Home with you Bundle
- **Card Stock/DSP** – Whisper White; Garden Green; Old Olive; Crumb Cake; Soft Suede; Fresh Florals DSP Stack; Wood Textures DSP
- **Stamp Pads** – Real Red; Soft Suede; Tuxedo Black Momento Ink; Old Olive; Versamark
- **Misc.** – Adhesive /snail; Gold Embossing Powder; Gold Foil; Stampin Blends; Bigshot; Score board / tool, Tombow.

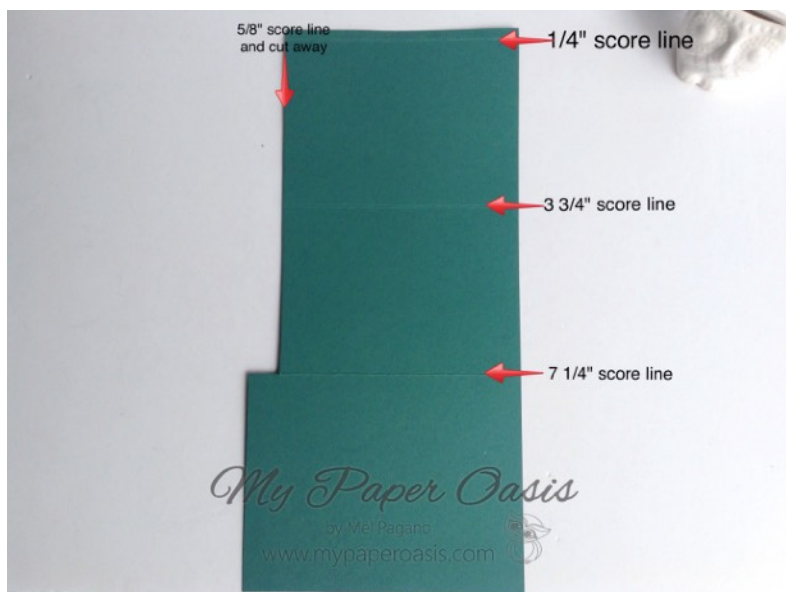
## Measurements: Card Base

- Garden Green Card Base - cut 11 1/2" x 5 1/2"
- Garden Green Front Panel 2 3/4" x 4 1/4"

## Instructions: Card Base

1. Score Long side of card base at 1/4", 3 3/4" and 7 1/4".
2. Rotate card base 90 degrees, orientating the 1/4" mark to the top of your score board. Score at 5/8" ONLY down to last score mark.
3. Cut this scored section away.

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4. Have the largest panel on your right hand side and then fold card base in a concertina fashion. You should finish with the 1/4" panel at the front on the left hand side of your card base.
5. Place snail or adhesive on the front of the 1/4" fold and then adhere your Garden Green Front Panel to this. Trim away the small excess of fold at the top.
6. You now have your base for a Four Panel Card.





#### **Instructions: Card Front**

1. Using Soft Suede ink, stamp the door image from the At Home with You Bundle onto a piece of Crumb Cake Card Stock.
2. Cut this image out using the matching framelit and the bigshot machine.
3. Using adhesive, adhere the door to the front panel, lining up the top of the door image with the top of the card base.
4. Using Old Olive Ink, stamp the Garland image from the At Home with You Bundle onto Whisper White Cardstock and then cut this image out using the matching framelit.
5. Colour the berries with the Light Cherry Cobbler Stampin Blend Pen.
6. Using adhesive such as tombow, run a thin strip of glue around the bottom edge of the garland and down each side. Adhere to the top of your door.
7. Using Real Red Ink, stamp the Welcome Image from the At Home with You Bundle onto a piece of Whisper White Cardstock and then cut this image out using the matching framelit.
8. Adhere to the bottom of the door.



**Measurements: Left Side Panel (Panel One)**

- Whisper White Layer - 2 1/2" x 4"
- Lemon Lime Twist DSP - 2 1/2" x 1 1/2"

**Instructions: Left Side Panel (Panel One)**

1. Using Real Red Ink, stamp the A Wish For Everything Merry sentiment from the Ready for Christmas Bundle, onto the top part of your Whisper White card piece.
2. Using adhesive, adhere your Lemon Lime Twist DSP to the base of your Whisper White Card piece.
3. Centre and Adhere to the Garden Green Left hand panel, ensuring the card covers the join.

**Measurements: Ride Side Panel (panel two)**

- Whisper White Layer - 3 x 4 3/8"

**Instructions: Ride Side Panel (panel two)**

1. Using adhesive, adhere your Whisper White Layer to the right hand panel (second inside panel) of your card base.
2. Using the bigshot, cut the Stairs framelit out of a piece of Wood Textures DSP. Using adhesive such as tombow, adhere the stairs to the bottom left of your Whisper White piece, ensuring the bottom edges align.
3. Using Old Olive Ink, stamp the Garland from the Ready for Christmas Bundle onto Whisper White Cardstock. Cut out the image using the matching framelit.
4. Adhere to the top of the staircase using tombow.
5. Using momento ink, stamp 3 stocking images from the Ready for Christmas Bundle onto Whisper White cardstock. Colour one each in Dark Daffodil Delight; Light Bermuda Bay and Light Cherry Cobbler Stampin Blends.
6. Cut the images out using the matching framelit and adhere to stairs as pictured using tombow.
7. Cut 3 bows from the Ready for Christmas Bundle Framelits in Gold Foil. Using tombow, adhere one to the top of each stocking.



#### Measurements: Left Inside Panel (panel three)

- Whisper White Layer - 3 1/4" x 4 5/8"
- Wood Textures DSP - 3" x 4 3/8"

#### Instructions: Left Inside Panel

1. Using adhesive, centre and adhere your Whisper White piece to your third panel.
2. Using adhesive, centre and adhere your Wood Textures DSP to the Whisper White piece.
3. Using your bigshot cut out the Tree Framelit and 6 fronds from the Ready for Christmas Bundle in Old Olive card stock.
4. Using tombow, adhere the fronds to the tree by applying a small amount of tombow to the top section of the fronds. The fronds line up with the tree shape. Begin at the bottom of the tree and work up to the top. You will need 3 for the bottom row, 2 for the middle section and 1 for the top of the tree.
5. Centre and adhere your tree to the Wood Textures DSP.
6. Using the bigshot, cut one star using the framelit from the Ready for Christmas Bundle in Gold Foil. Using tombow, adhere to the top of the tree.
7. Using versamark ink, stamp the baubles from the Ready for Christmas Bundle onto Whisper White cardstock. Sprinkle with Gold Embossing Powder and Heat set.
8. Using matching framelit, cut baubles out and adhere to tree fronds using tombow.
9. Using Momento ink, stamp two presents (the square present and the tall present) onto Whisper White Cardstock. Colour using Stampin Blends - the square present in Light Cherry Cobbler with the bow in Dark Pool Party and the tall present with Light Bermuda Bay and the bow with Dark Daffodil Delight.
10. Arrange presents 'under' the tree as pictured and adhere.

#### Measurements: Right Hand Panel (panel four)

- Whisper White Layer - 4" x 5 1/4"
- Fresh Florals DSP Layer - 3 3/4" x 5"
- Wood Textures DSP strip - 1/2" x 3 3/4"

**Instructions: Right Hand Panel (panel four)**

1. Using adhesive, centre and adhere your Whisper White piece to your third panel.
2. Using adhesive, adhere your Wood Textures DSP strip to the base of the Fresh Florals DSP piece ensuring that the edges line up.
3. Using adhesive, centre and adhere to your Whisper White Layer.
4. Using Soft Suede Ink, stamp the image of the table onto Soft Suede Card stock. Cut the image using the matching framelit.
5. Adhere the table left of centre, ensuring the feet of the table sit on the Wood Textures DSP strip.
6. Using momento ink, stamp the dog, cookies and 3 different picture frames onto Whisper White Cardstock.
7. Colour the images using Stampin Blends:  
*Cookies* - Light Cherry Cobbler for the plate and Light Crumb Cake for the Cookies;  
*Dog* - jumper with Light Bermuda Bay and Dark Daffodil Delight; Fur with Dark and Light Crumb Cake;  
*Frames* - using Dark Crumb Cake around outer edge of frames and Light Crumb Cake for inner edge of frames;  
*Lights* - Light Old Olive; Dark Daffodil Delight; Light Bermuda Bay and Light Cherry Cobbler  
*Holly* - Light Old Olive and Light Cherry Cobbler for berries;  
*Snowflake* - Dark Pool Party
8. Cut each image out using the matching Framelits.
9. Adhere the cookie plate to sit on top of the table.
10. Adhere the dog as though standing on his hind legs to get the cookies.
11. Arrange and adhere picture Frames as pictured or as desired.
